

## Limited FSA Eligible Expense List

Per IRS regulations, the following, while not intended to be complete, illustrates examples of eligible dental and vision expenses. Expenses must be incurred during the Plan Year from which you are requesting reimbursement. Expenses are considered incurred when service is rendered, not when service is billed or payment is made. Expenses cannot be reimbursed in advance of the date service is rendered.

### Examples of Eligible Expenses:

- Artificial teeth
- Dental braces
- Contact lenses
- Contact lens cleaner
- Dental fillings
- Dental x-rays
- Dental sealants
- Dentures
- Eye examination
- Eyeglasses
- Fluoridation services
- Keratotomy
- Laser Eye Surgery – Lasik
- Long-term care services
- Occlusal guards - prevents teeth grinding
- Optometrist
- Orthodontia
- Reading glasses
- Vision correction procedures

Eligible Items Subject to Change

### Examples of Ineligible Expenses:

- Dental floss
- Mouthwash
- Toothbrushes
- Toothpaste
- Teeth whitening/bleaching
- Veneers
- Dental/vision discount programs
